TRACK DAY

COMPULSORY DRIVING LICENCE

Drivers must hold a valid B driving licence on the day of the event, or a valid driver's license.

DISCHARGE

Each driver will have to sign a "waiver of liability" (annexed document) at the compulsory administrative check.

COMPULSORY SAFETY BRIEFING

All drivers must attend the safety briefing. A reminder of the safety rules (driving, attitude...) will be given.

ACCESS

Each driver will be given a bracelet corresponding to the day of the race and giving him access to the circuit. Each accompanying person must be registered on the staff list and will be given a wristband at the entrance after signing the COVID-19 waiver.

CIVIL LIABILITY INSURANCE

Each driver will have to provide a civil liability insurance for this ride. (Damage and accident insurance is also recommended).

DAMAGE CAUSED

Damage to the circuit caused by running off the track is the responsibility of the driver/owner.

ALCOHOL / DRUGS

All drivers must undertake not to have consumed alcohol or drugs before and during the days of driving in which they participate.

IMAGE RIGHTS

You authorize the organizer to photograph and/or film you during participation in the track days and to use these materials for all promotional and communication purposes, including advertising and commercial. It is not permitted to sell or use the images taken by you or a third party during the track days for advertising or commercial purposes.

FORCE MAJEURE

In the event of force majeure, the organizer cannot be held responsible. The decision to interrupt a run may be taken if safety conditions cannot be ensured and if they are considered dangerous.

CAR EQUIPMENT

Make sure to have your car checked beforehand (state of the tyres, state of the brakes, fluids, etc.). Your car must be in perfect working order to participate in the driving days. The towing hook is mandatory.

COMPULSORY EQUIPMENT FOR DRIVER AND CO-DRIVER

Racing car: helmet, fireproof suit and gloves, shoes, Hans-type system... approved and compulsory.
Registered production car: homologated helmet obligatory on track. Long trousers and long sleeves.
A maximum of one passenger in front of the car. No one in the back of the car is allowed.

NOISE CONTROL

Each vehicle must comply with imposed noise standards. For Nogaro, the emission limit is 100db. If the limit is exceeded, the car will have to be brought into compliance, if not, it will not be allowed to run.

ACCOMPANYERS

It is everyone's responsibility to come to the track days with restricted personnel as part of the covid-19 pandemic.
